

Spectator Code of Conduct – Northern Lakes League

- Section 1 Spectators are an important part of the game and shall at all times conform to accepted standards of good sportsmanship and behavior.
- Section 2 Spectators shall at all times respect officials, coaches and players and extend all courtesies to them.
- Section 3 Wholesome cheering is encouraged.
- Taunting, foul and abusive language, inflammatory remarks, and disrespectful Section 4 behavior are not acceptable.
- Section 5 Spectators shall respect and obey all school administrators, staff and police at all athletic contests.
- Section 6 At no time during a contest are spectators allowed on the playing surface unless directed by a school administrator.
- Section 7 Should a spectator be removed from a contest for any behavior deemed inappropriate, the punishment shall be the following:

1st Ejection: A minimum 2 game suspension (may be longer if deemed necessary by the school administration). The offender cannot attend at least 2 games of the sport ejected from and all other NLL sporting events during that time period. The offender must schedule a conference with the athletic director and the principal to discuss their inappropriate behavior and discuss a plan to improve said behavior.

Any further ejections from any other NLL sporting events will result in the school's administration determining further consequences with the offender.

Section 8 The school administration can evaluate each incident and extend the suspension lengths mentioned above but cannot shorten the suspension.
